

## San Dieguito Water District: Conservation Programs

San Dieguito Water District participates with the San Diego County Water Authority and Metropolitan Water District in providing incentives for customers to upgrade to water conserving devices. Below is a list of incentives available to customers. If you are in need of assistance, or have questions, please contact SDWD's water conservation division at 760-633-2676.

Please note that the Multi-Family Housing Conservation Programs (more than 4 dwelling units) are joined with the Commercial Programs. Smart Landscape Programs are listed separately.

The rebate programs are region-wide. This document lists the rebate amounts available to San Dieguito Water District customers.

<b>Single Family Residential Programs ***</b>	
The program will begin again on September 21, 2009.	
Funds are limited and will be distributed on a first come - first served basis.	
Rebate reservations are not required for the residential program.	
Products purchased before the September 21st reinstatement of the program are not eligible for rebates.	
Rebate applications and proof of purchase must be postmarked within 30 days of purchase to be eligible.

High Efficiency Toilet for Single Family	\$ 50.00
High Efficiency Clothes Washer for Single Family (water factor 4.0 or less)	\$ 100.00
Rotating Nozzles (requires matching pressure regulating device)	\$4 per nozzle
Weather Based Irrigation Controllers (for property < 1 acre)	\$ 80.00
Weather Based Irrigation Controllers (for property > 1 acre)	\$25 per station

<b>Note: A customer can only put in one application for rotating nozzles, but it can be for as many nozzles as you need for the one address.</b>

### Commercial & Multi-family Programs \*\*\*

**As of January 4, 2009, there are only reservations for multi-family high efficiency clothes washers available.**

Rebate **reservations ARE required** for the Commercial and Multi-Family program. Reservations must be made on line prior to purchase: [www.mwdsaveabuck.com](http://www.mwdsaveabuck.com)

After obtaining a reservation, participants must purchase and install the device and submit the completed application with supporting documentation including proof of purchase (original receipts). This must be postmarked within 45 days of purchase.

For multi-family dwellings with 4 units or less, please visit the single family programs.

Rebates may only cover up to 50% of the cost of the device. Check the website for details.

<b>Residential Survey:</b> Single Family Residential Customers. Professional survey of indoor and outdoor water use with recommendations for saving water and money.	free to customer
<b>Mini Audit:</b> Available for residences or commercial properties with at least 1 acre of landscaped area or smaller. This includes a report on outdoor water usage, landscape and system hardware inefficiencies and recommendations on measures to save water and money. This is a good start to determine how to update your landscape &/or irrigation system and save money and water. Commercial properties with smaller lots may also be considered for this program. <b>Large Landscape Audit:</b> HOA's & Commercial Customers: Professional landscape auditor study and report on outdoor water usage, landscape system hardware.
