

Updated Irrigation Schedule

The District's Drought Ordinance called for a seasonal shift of the irrigation schedule from three days a week from June through October to one day a week from November through May. Due to an extraordinary customer response to the District's calls for water conservation, the District will continue with the current three-days-per-week schedule until further notice. Odd-numbered homes can continue to irrigate on Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday; even-numbered homes can irrigate on Saturday, Monday and Wednesday; and multi-family or non-residential properties can water on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Other restrictions on outdoor water use will remain unchanged: irrigation is limited to ten minutes per station and only between the hours of 6 p.m. and 8 a.m. for residential customers.

Customers should be aware that cooler temperatures and shorter days do provide opportunities to save water this fall and winter. Over-watering occurs mostly during the fall season, and it can be as damaging to landscapes as under-watering. Also, please turn off irrigation systems as rainy weather approaches. Systems can be left off for up to a week following storms, depending on the amount of rainfall.
